TRAIL FUNDING:

EQUIPMENT:

On May 3rd 2007 we held our "First Annual Equipment Meeting". This meeting was held to assess our grooming equipment and implement a plan of action to move forward in to the future. Based on re-sale value, condition,

quality of grooming, and club needs; we implemented a new system of rating equipment. This new system applies a High, Good or Poor rating to each piece. In applying a rating, at this annual meeting, we will be better able to decide on which equipment to keep (service), sell or replace. This year the Skandic and Drag is valued at High after some repairs are made; estimated repairs to be done are a maximum of \$500. The Bombi and Drag is valued as Good after some repairs are made; estimated repairs to be done are a maximum of \$1500. Due to the above base line of each, both pieces of equipment are headed in for servicing soon and will be tuned up and improved so they are ready to go right to work well in advance of the 2007-2008 winter season. It was also decided to move ahead with a new equipment purchase to join our fleet. We are looking at a brand new small unit with a drag at a dollar value of approximately \$29,000. This purchase would be spread out over 7 years with the goal of paying it off ahead of schedule. We are still in the preliminary stages, but we're seriously looking at equipment options, funding, finances, and banking. If you are interested in or have ideas regarding the equipment please contact the Equipment Coordinator. Other goals set at this meeting were to improve the grooming as much as possible through equipment and manpower and have a turn over of equipment every three years until we have an equipment fleet consisting of 4 to 5 units.
